MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE
June 2, 2009

CALL TO ORDER: Chairman Wessler called the meeting to order at 6:03 p.m.

PRESENT: Upon roll call by Deputy Village Clerk, Corey Williamsen, the following Board Members were present:

Interim Village Manager, Michael Cassady, asked the Committee to move agenda item 7 to item 1 on the agenda. There were no objections from the Committee.

Blue Bin Recycling Program:

Mr. Cassady presented to the Committee the blue bin recycling program. The Village received a grant to proceed with the program in 2007. The program was delayed. The new Blue Bin program will raise the resident's bill twenty cents a month. The program gives each resident a recycling bin, Residents will no longer need to use plastic bags, and will no longer need to separate recycled items. An educational program will be available to the residents for proper recycling. Residents will be allowed to throw away bulk items that can not fit into a garbage can. If the Village Board decides not choose the program, the recycling process will remain the same. Residents that throw away bulk items will need purchase a sticker for \$1.50 per item.

Motion: Trustee Bartlett made a motion to approve the Blue Bin Recycling Program at a cost of \$0.20 per month, maintaining unlimited refuse collection. Trustee O'Connell seconded the motion.

**188 S Church
Road:**

Director of Public Works, Paul Quinn, presented to the Committee a residential complaint at 188 S. Church Road. The property gathers water from various streets and surrounding area every time it rains. The current pipe reduces in size from 21" to 18" on Ellis Ave. Mr. Quinn shared plans with the Committee in resolving this issue. The block grant project will provide the Village an opportunity to mitigate flooding to some extent on this lot.

Water ponds causing overland flooding to some structures on Miner during sever rain storms. Mr. Quinn shared plans with the Committee in resolving this issue which included the construction of a rear yard relief sewer pending approved funding.

Traffic Calming
Request:**

The concern is for the safety of the children at the park on Poplar Street. Staff does not recommend approval of this. There has been no police reports filed for this area. Street maintenance for plowing and sweeping will be affected. Fire trucks and ambulance will be slowed down as well. Wood Dale had a petition filed at the City Hall. Mr. Quinn requested a copy of the petition and has not received one yet.
