Dear Mr. Devens:

I am pleased to help you with your April 17, 2018 Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"). The Village of Bensenville received your request on April 18, 2018. You requested copies of the items indicated below:

"Permit fees and plans for Thorntons Gas Station (601 IL 83). Final approvals for Thorntons Gas Station (601 IL 83). Any and all documents related to the Thorntons Gas Station development (601 IL 83)."

The Village attempted to contact you via phone on April 20, 2018 with the contact number provided on your FOIA request form. A voicemail was left.

The Village emailed you at the email address provided on your FOIA request form on April 23, 2018 with no response.

The Village Board unanimously approved an ordinance on October 9, 2012 entitled *"An Ordinance Concerning an Application for Two Conditional Use Permits to Allow a Gasoline and Diesel Fuel Service Station and Associated Electronic Message Center Signs with Associated Variances at 601 N. Route 83, Bensenville, Illinois"*.


You've requested to receive the documents electronically; however, due to the size of the file, the Village is unable to email it to you.

Also, Section 7(1)(K) of FOIA provided that architects' plans, engineers' technical submissions, and other construction related or developed in whole or in part with public funds and the same of projects constructed or developed with public funds, including but not limited to power generating and distribution stations and other transmission and distribution facilities, water treatment facilities, airport facilities, sports stadiums, convention centers, and all government owned, operated or occupied buildings, but only to the extent that disclosure would comprise security are exempt from disclosure.
