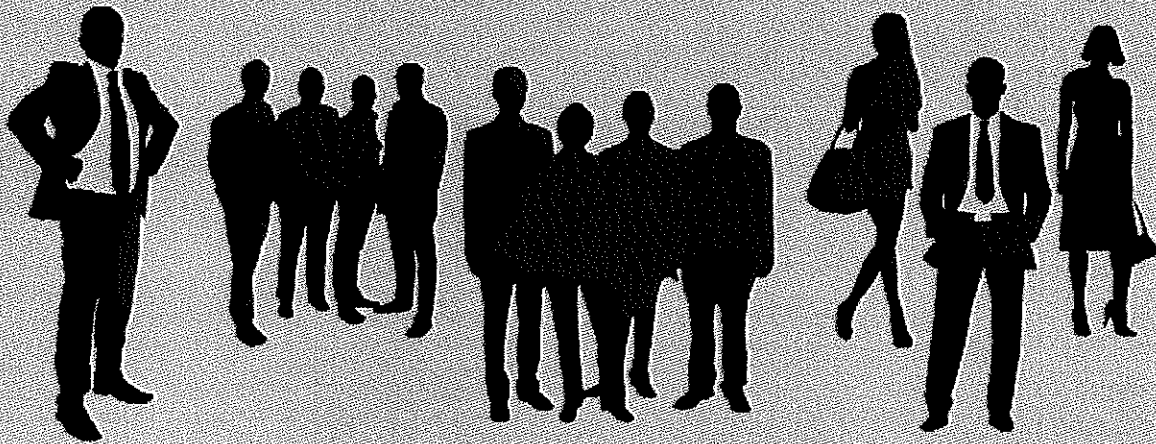

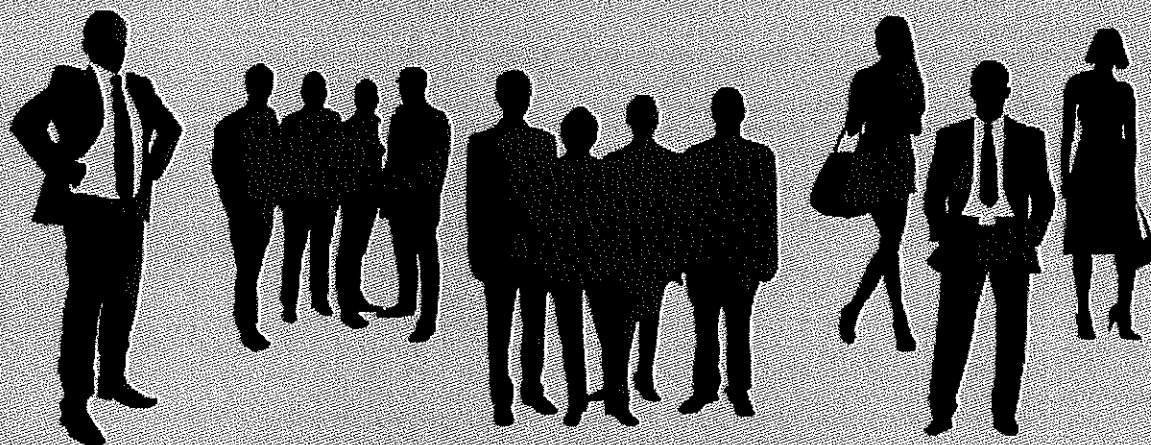

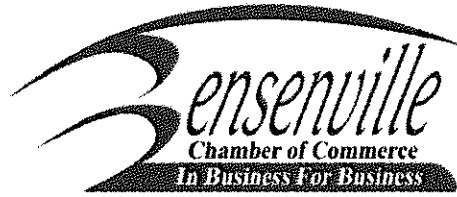

The Village of Bensenville, over the last several years, has made a concerted effort to partner with the Bensenville Chamber of Commerce in order to foster a pro-business climate within our community. From our joint fundraisers, to grand openings, to cooperatively resolving business disputes, to successful golf outing sponsorships, to expediting permits – our successes are well documented.

For years, however, Chamber Director Paul DeMichele has seemingly opposed the Village's efforts at every turn. He constantly speaks out against the Village, elicits ire through inaccurate claims, creates subversive business groups, circulates petitions opposing reinvestment in infrastructure, and has filed over 15 inane FOIA requests in the last year alone.

The Village implores the Board of Directors for the Bensenville Chamber of Commerce to take clear and meaningful steps to correct the damaged relationship between our organizations that stem from the transgressions of Mr. Paul DeMichele.
